Chairman Stanton called the meeting to order at 4:01PM

Chairman Stanton introduced the parties and summarized issues related to City Moves proposed uses in the Business Park.

Eric Carlson explained that retail uses are not allowed in the Business Park.

Kate McCormick stated that retail use was misstated in the Special Permit application. They are not planning on selling to the general public, but will be selling boxes, etc. to customers who they are moving.

Kevin Moran stated that the storage building is not self-storage. The building will be accessible only from the inside and is not accessible to customers but will be controlled by City Moves. This climate controlled interior accessible building will only have two doors to access a center interior aisle.

The project is a three phase building project with only two parts being applied for a Special Permit.

Selectman Macy suggested that the Selectmen send a memo to the Planning Board about what has been reviewed by the Board for proposed uses and buildings.

Kate McCormack will draft an outline of City Moves proposed project, as discussed in meeting, and will send to the Board of Selectmen with a copy of the Planning Board.

Selectman Macy moved to adjourn, seconded by Selectman Hannum. Motion carried unanimously. Chairman Stanton adjourned the meeting at 4:28PM.
